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Personal Data and Consent Form

Please be aware that the Registration Form requests personal data from you and your child/ren and that when you submit the completed Registration Form to the School, the School collects this data, processes it and uses it in the ways listed below.  asked by these governments to provide your personal data. In this eventuality, the School will comply with the
 EU Data Protection Regulation when sending the requested data.

You have the right to request all your personal data held by the School and the right to request that inaccurate information is erased or corrected.

Your personal data will be removed from the School records after your children have left the school, although some of the data may be kept where there is a legal requirement to do so.

You have the right to withdraw your consent to the processing of your data at any time, and the right to ask the School to delete all your records and in this case please write to us to request this. However, please note that your child cannot be registered as a pupil at the School unless the data can be collected and processed as above.

The School will always treat your personal data in a confidential way and in accordance with the current legislation.

The School needs your consent to collect and process your personal data in the ways described above, otherwise your child/ren will not be able to be registered.

School Fees
